Itinerary Note: The Itinerary details are at the approval/specification of the group leader and/or the ground operator and the execution thereof accomplished by the group leader together with the guide. Several days may include extended walking that some may find strenuous. At various sites, there is limited or no handicap accessibility. Please keep in mind due to circumstances beyond control and due to the nature of this type of touring this itinerary is subject to modifications and/or changes. Sites may be altered, cancelled or substitutions made at the discretion of your group leader, the ground operator and/or the guide. Please refer to the Group Member Terms & Conditions for additional information.

Hotels: The price is quoted per person sharing double occupancy and a minimum group size. The right is reserved to substitute hotels of similar category if necessary.

Single Rooms: If you do not have a roommate and JDI Tours is unable to arrange one you must pay a supplemental room charge. A limited number of single rooms are available; therefore, hotels reserve the right to charge double occupancy when only 1 person stays in a room. Please note that cancellations due to not being granted a single room are subject to the standard cancellation policy.

Travel Documents: It is the passenger's responsibility to acquire all travel documents. A passport and/or certified copy of your birth certificate with photo ID, along with all necessary tourist cards, visas and health certificates, depending on your destination, are the passenger's responsibility. Contact consulate generals/ embassy for your country of destination for information. **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU EXPEDITE YOUR DOCUMENTS. PASSPORT OFFICES CAN EXPERIENCE DIFFICULTY MEETING DELIVERY DEADLINES.**

Health Requirements/Vaccinations:

Land Only (L/O): Air related tour inclusions listed in "This Tour Includes" section of this form or on other tour documents such as group member registration forms, itineraries, flyers are not applicable to non-air (L/O) packages. Flight Schedule terms and all other air related terms herein apply.

Baggage: Due to the changing nature of regulations concerning baggage allowances, contact airline for the most up to date information.

Individual Changes: Custom itineraries deviating from group itinerary may result in additional cost for airfare, transfers, hotel rates and are the passenger's responsibility.

Flight Schedules: Can be subject to change by the airline without advance notice. JDI Tours cannot be responsible for changes and/ or delays in airline schedules, flight cancellations or circumstances that may result from the cancellations, delays or changes. Because airlines do change flight times and sometime even dates, then we strongly advise that the domestic ticket you purchase be a fare that can be exchanged without heavy penalties or fees. If the airlines change their flight schedule, JDI Tours reserves the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, which could mean a price increase to accommodate these changes.

Refunds or Exchange of Unused Arrangements: Unused hotel accommodations, meals, or any other service or feature of the tour arising from any and all unforeseen and/or uncontrollable circumstances and/or discretions of the group leader, guide or other agents are not refundable or exchangeable for other accommodations, services or features.

USD\$/Foreign Currency Exchange: Some of the costs in your tour may be based upon foreign currency exchanges. In the event of significant fluctuation in the exchange rate additional cost may be included and may be required by vendors any time prior to time of departure.

Limitation of Liability: Group Leaders, Escorts and/or Tour Administrators are not in the employ of JDI Travel Inc unless otherwise indicated. The tour operator (JDI Tours) and all cooperating agencies and tour operators, act only in the capacity of agents for the hotels, airlines, bus companies, railroads, ship lines, group leaders or owners/contractors providing accommodations, transportation or other services (hereinafter: suppliers) and all coupons, exchange orders, receipts, vouchers, contracts and tickets issued by tour operator are issued subject to any and all tariffs, terms and conditions under which any accommodation, transportation or any other whatsoever are provided by such supplier or by any person in employ. By the acceptance of tour membership and/or such coupons, exchange orders, vouchers, receipts, contracts and tickets, the tour member agrees to the foregoing and also agrees that neither the tour operator, nor any of its employees or affiliates shall be or become liable for any loss, injury, damage, added expenses or costs in connection with any accommodations, transportation or other services, resulting directly or indirectly from any acts of God, danger, incident to the sea, fire, breakdown in machines or equipment, act of government or other authorities, de jure or de facto wars, whether declared or not, hostilities, civil disturbances, strikes, riots, thefts, pilferage, epidemics, quarantines, medical or customs regulation, improper visas, passports or other travel documents, defaults, cancellations, delays from any causes beyond the tour operator's control, or for any loss or damage resulting from the negligent act or omission of any supplier or other parties. If an airline declares bankruptcy, it is not obligated to carry you or to refund tickets issued before the bankruptcy. Travel Agents are not allowed to refund tickets on airlines, which have declared bankruptcy. If an airline declares bankruptcy it might continue service, limit service, or stop completely. If minimum group size does not materialize, group member non-refundable registration fees may be applied toward other travel services. (Also refer to Airline Seat Deposit section) Should the group size change or group cancel, prices may be affected. By embarking upon his/her tour, the traveler voluntarily assumes all risk of damage or loss involved with such risks, and is ADVISED TO

OBTAIN APPROPRIATE INSURANCE COVERAGE AGAINST THEM. Traveler's signed Registration Form, retention of tickets, reservations, or booking after issuance shall constitute a consent to the above, and an agreement on traveler's part to convey the contents hereto his/her travel companions or group members.

Tour Operator Cancellation Option: Tour operator reserves the right to refuse any person, before or during the tour, and to cancel or change the tour, hotel, airlines or sightseeing should circumstances warrant at tour operator's judgment. (Also refer to Cancellation Terms)

Emergency Action Plan (EAP): Having an "Emergency Action Plan" or "EAP" when traveling is recommended. A basic plan would include an emergency contact list of people to call in the event of an accident or illness, your health and/or travel insurance papers, copies of your passport/visa(s), names of any medications or foods that you are allergic to, financial information required for replacement of traveler's checks or debit/credit cards (kept confidential). Give copies of your EAP to someone at home in the USA such as your family members/relatives/ guardians, friends, power of attorney, secretary or other. Be alert and aware of your surroundings and make a mental note of exit routes in hotels and on modes of transportation. Remember do not use elevators in the event of a fire or emergency evacuation from a building. Calling and/or registering with the US Embassy or US Consular General in the country you are visiting is wise especially for longer stays and if you are traveling without a group or guide. In some cases the US Bureau of Consular Affairs can assist with arrangements for emergency medical needs (but not with costs). In the event of political upheaval and terrorism the US State Dept. sets up a task force to help provide assistance to US citizens abroad. And remember that travel insurance is strongly recommended.
